Evanston 150 Hosts Interactive Voting Sessions at Century Cinema, Evanston Township High School and Saint Francis Hospital

EVANSTON, IL—Evanston residents will have an opportunity to choose the 30 best ideas for the city's future on Oct. 15 & 16. A series of voting sessions will be hosted by Evanston150, allowing community members to vote on the 100 ideas that were selected by a 21-person selection jury of community members.
