## 2012 REUNION TOUR TO POLAND WITH JAN LEWANDOWSKI, BIG DADDY AND HANK GUZEVICH

**May 9 /Wed - USA/WARSAW.** Today board your overnight transatlantic flights for the Polish capital with movies and meals on board.

**May 10 /Thu - WARSAW.** Upon arrival, meet your guides and settle-in at your hotel located in the heart of the city. This evening, a welcome dinner with a folklore performance and entertainment by Jan Lewan, Hank Guzevich and Big Daddy. (D)

**May 11/Fri - WARSAW/GDANSK.** This morning your motorcoaches depart for the Baltic coast through Poland's beautiful countryside. Balance of the day is free. Walk to the Old Town and catch a first glimpse of this historic city. (B, D)

**May 12/Sat - GDANSK.** Today discover many attractions of the area. Start in Gdansk splendidly restored to its former glory when it was one of the most prosperous ports of Europe. Walk through the Gdansk's old town with magnificent Burghers' houses to St. Mary's Church, largest brick Gothic church in Poland. Continue to the Oliwa Cathedral where you will hear a concert on its unique organ. Visit chic resort of Sopot with luxury spa hotels and walk on the longest wooden pier on the Baltic. Lunch is planned on a "Pirate" ship with a POLKA PARTY AT SEA. Return to Gdansk via Lenin's Shipyard, the birthplace of Solidarity. (B, L)

**May 13/Sun - GDANSK-Malbork-WARSAW.** After morning Mass your motorcoaches head for the

heroic Polish capital. En route stop in Malbork to tour the fascinating castle of the mighty Teutonic Knights in the 15th century, Europe's largest fortified brick castle. After lunch continue to Warsaw for overnight (B, L)

**May 14/Mon - WARSAW.** After buffet breakfast get acquainted with this remarkable city largely destroyed during WWII and rebuilt with great care. Your tour includes the colorful Old Town with fashionable restaurants, shops and cozy cafes, the Royal Castle Square and St John's Cathedral. Via Royal Route studded with palaces and monuments, continue to Lazienki Park built by last monarch of Poland and stop at the monument of Polish composer, F. Chopin. Balance of day is free to walk around the old town and Nowy Swiat Street - Polish Fifth Avenue. This evening dinner is planned in a local restaurant. (B, D)

**May 15/Tue - WARSAW-Czestochowa-ZAKOPANE.** This morning journey South to Czestochowa, pilgrimage center of Poland where Fr. Simon will meet you for a special tour of the Jasna Gora Monastery where the miraculous icon of the Black Madonna is venerated. After lunch in a local restaurant, continue via Wadowice, birthplace of blessed Pope John Paul II, to the resort of Zakopane hidden in the majestic Tatra Mountains. (B, L)

**May 16/Wed - ZAKOPANE.** Your exciting tour

continues with a relaxing day on a nine-mile fun ride on rafts down the Dunajec River. Return to Zakopane for time at leisure. Your day ends with a picnic where you will be entertained by the Highlanders "Gorale" and taste local specialties. (B, D)

**May 17/Thu - ZAKOPANE-Wieliczka-KRAKOW.** After breakfast depart for the medieval city of Krakow. En route stop to tour the Wieliczka Salt Mine and discover its underground wonders carved from salt on a 1.5 mile tourist route. Balance of day is free to explore wonderful souvenir shops. At tonight's dinner, enjoy a folklore performance. (B, D)

**May 18/Fri - KRAKOW.** Today you will spend discovering medieval treasures of Krakow, city of legends and traditions which was spared destruction of World War II. Walking tour of the Old Town includes the impressive Wawel Hill with the Coronation Cathedral and royal chambers from where Polish kings ruled for four centuries. Afternoon is free to spend at the Market Square full of souvenir shops, lively sidewalk cafes, museums and restaurants. In the evening a farewell POLKA PARTY in the hotel will end your unforgettable vacation in Poland. (B, D)

**May 19/Sat - KRAKOW/USA.** This morning depart for the airport, bid "do widzenia" to your guides and fly home. (B)

### TOUR CONDITIONS:

**RESERVATIONS/PAYMENTS:** A deposit of \$300 per person payable by check or a major credit card is required at the time of booking. Full payment is due March 24, 2012 payable by check. The tour cost includes a built-in discount of 2% for payment by cash or check. There is no discount on credit card sales.

**TOUR COST:** Tour price is based on group airfares and currency exchange levels in effect in May 2011. It is subject to adjustment in the event of significant changes in the exchange levels or any surcharges imposed by the airlines.

**TOUR/AIR ARRANGEMENTS:** Air transportation will be provided by LOT Polish Airlines and/or Lufthansa Airlines. Hotel accommodations will be provided in twin or double rooms with private bath. Single rooms are available at the supplement shown. While every effort will be made to provide sharing of accommodations for persons booking alone, when requested, it cannot be guaranteed and single supplement must be paid before departure when billed. Triple rooms are not available. Children under the age of seven are not accepted.

Unused hotel accommodations or any other unused features of this tour are not refundable or exchangeable for other services. The right is reserved to substitute hotels and sightseeing features if it becomes necessary.

Tour members must be able to get on and off the motorcoach unaided and not require walking devices or wheelchairs.

**NOT INCLUDED IN THE TOUR COST:** Cost of passports, items of a personal nature; phone calls, laundry, optional insurance, gratuities to guides and bus drivers.

**BAGGAGE:** Your free checked baggage allowance is one suitcase per person not exceeding 50 lbs plus one carry-on.

**NO VACCINATIONS** are required by law.

**DOCUMENTS:** A valid U.S. or foreign passport is required. To apply for passport, contact your local Post Office. Check the validity of your passport. Passport should be valid for at least three months after your return date.

**CANCELLATIONS:** All cancellations must be made in writing to PAT TOURS. Full refund will be made for cancellations received up to 45 days prior to departure less a \$25 administrative fee. Between 44-36 days deposit of \$300 is non-refundable. No refund will be made for cancellations received less than 35 days prior to departure. AIRLINE TICKETS, when issued, are subject to the airline policy applicable to the airfare used. After completion of the tour, claims for refund must be made in writing within 30 days.
