Mr. Krieger:

It has come to my knowledge that one of my patients is being forced to receive the 'smart' meters being installed in your city. Because of the sensitive condition of her heart and potential for interference of the new devices, it is my expert medical opinion that her household not receive the 'smart' meter. The potential complications or interferences are not acceptable with her device. There is potential that this meter may interfere with the function of her cardiac device; this could cause a number of issues including but not limited to inappropriate shocks, cardiac device reprogramming and/or asynchronous pacing.

Until more reliable data can be collected on the health and safety of these 'smart' meters, it is not recommended that she has one of these installed in her home.
