**Date:** July 13, 2013

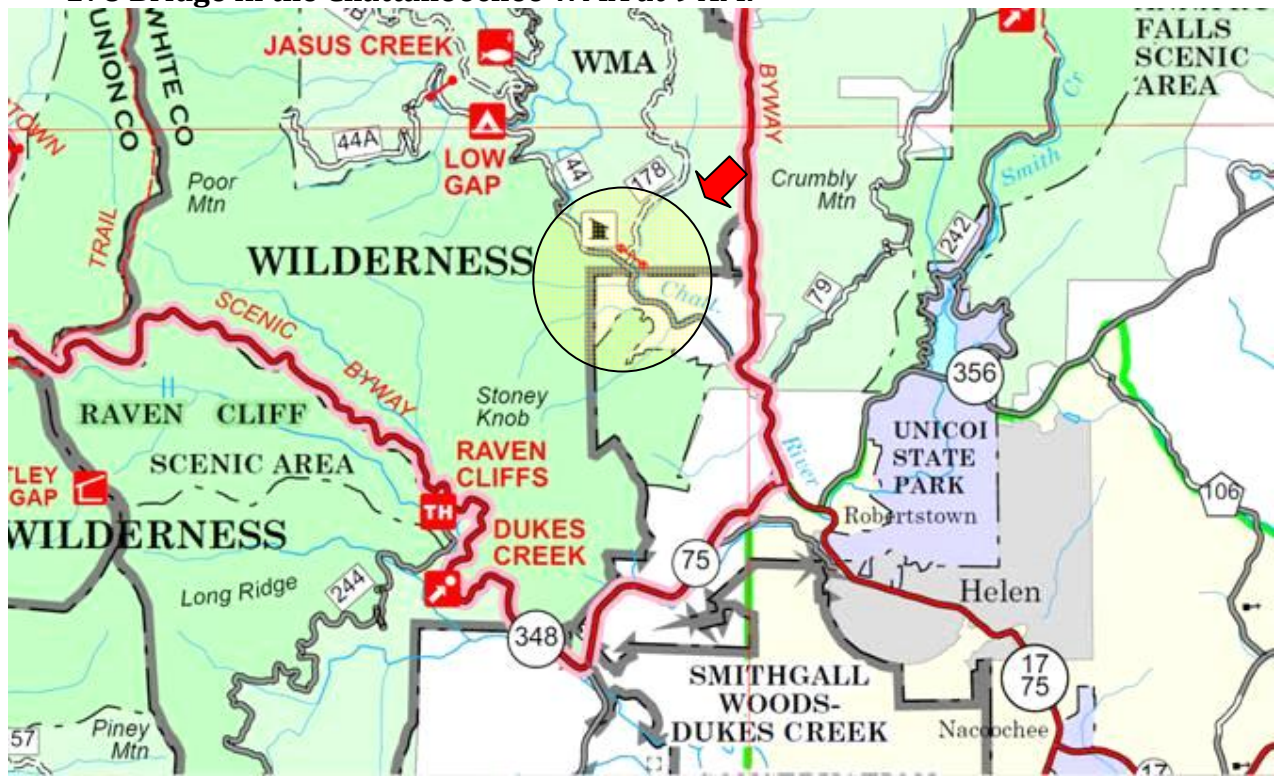
**Time:** 7:15 AM Depart Waffle House (Holcomb Bridge and Old Alabama Roads; Roswell)

**Mark your calendar to join** Oconee River, GA Foothills, Cohutta and Upper Chattahoochee River TU for a brook trout workday on the Chattahoochee River headwaters. The worksite is located on Martin Branch in the Chattahoochee WMA. We will be building instream structures to improve stream flow and provide habitat for brook trout. The workday is led by Upper Chattahoochee River TU but is open to any TU member. A hat and work gloves are the only equipment needed. But do bring plenty of drinking water due to the heat. *RSVP for Lunch. Bring a friend!*

UCCTU will depart the Waffle House at Holcomb Bridge and Old Alabama Roads just east of GA-400 in Roswell, GA at 7:15 AM (*sharp*) to carpool; arrive early for breakfast. Meet at FS 178 Bridge in the Chattahoochee WMA at 9 AM.



1. From Helen GA take GA 17/75 North toward Robertstown.
2. At Robertstown, pass Hwy 356 to Unicoi and turn left over the Chattahoochee River at the Flea Market.
3. Just over the river, turn right onto Polar Stump Road.
4. Follow Poplar Stump Rd. along the Chattahoochee River as it turns to gravel and enters the Chattahoochee WMA.
5. Park at the FS 178 Bridge. It is the first bridge that crosses the river to your right.
