10:15 am-Meet Rev. John DiNaro. Hear about John Bartow of the Bartow-Pell Mansion on the Pelham borderline in the Bronx.

Enjoy the 60 stained glass windows, and the first figural stained glass made in America.

11:15 am-Depart St. Anne's for Our Lady of Lebanon at 113 Remsen Street at Henry, a two-minute walk from the other church. 1 718-624-7228

11:30 am-Meet Monsignor James Root and see the luxurious bronze doors salvaged from the luxury French liner, Normandie, a church full of French heritage. Built before the Civil War, the church had a piece of Plymouth Rock embedded in the tower before the Lebanese Maronite Christians acquired it. Maronite priests are allowed to marry.

12:30 pm- Have lunch in Brooklyn Heights near one of its many town houses.

1:45 pm-Take subway back to Grand Central Station.

2:15 pm-3:00 pm-Take Metro North train to home station.

3:00 pm-3:30 pm-Home station arrival

TUES. JAN. 31ST

Meet at Grand Central at **9:00 am** or earlier. Take subway to Brooklyn Heights to 25 Columbia Heights to Jehovah's Witnesses home base – 30 different buildings 1-718-560-5000

10:00 am-Meet Robert Authier, coordinator. Split up into six groups of ten for a two-hour tour of the Kingdom Halls. See the dormitories, historic buildings, printing presses, garden and fountain.
