### **EVENT PROGRAM**

This year's conference will include *The Strategic Overview of Disaster Management for Water and Wastewater Utilities*, a 4 hour, CEU-eligible training developed by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security.

The training provides an overview of disaster management, covering the various natural and man-made (accidental or intentional) disasters and their effects on water and wastewater systems. Participants are guided through portions of the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) Response Protocol Toolbox (RPTB) to identify steps in the response and recovery processes. Case studies on a variety of disaster incidents, as well as hypothetical situations for water and wastewater incidents are examined. Participants will practice developing disaster response plans.
