**Recommended for 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> grades: (workshops approx. 75-90 minutes long)**

***What's Bugging You?* \$10 PER SCOUT**

Explore the world of bugs and other insects and arachnids through arts and crafts. Create a butterfly glider, study the stages of metamorphosis and visit the creatures in Feasts for Beasts, LICM's newest gallery. *Workshop fulfills Bear Ach. #5a, Cub Scout Wildlife Pin #1.*

***Kitchen Chemistry* \$12 PER SCOUT**

Science is all around us – it even hides in our homes! Become a kitchen chemist and create a delicious emulsion and a playful colloid; explore density and static electricity!

***Sense-sational!* \$10 PER SCOUT (Recommended for 1st–3rd graders)**

Exercise your senses in this special Museum tour with a twist. In select galleries and in our Studio use only ONE sense at a time to create human patterns, surround yourself with sound and learn if your nose knows! *(Please inform us of allergies at time of booking.)*

**Recommended for 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> grades: (workshops approx. 90-100 minutes long)**

***CSI: LICM!* \$12 PER SCOUT**

Use your powers of observation and other methods of detection to solve the mystery in the museum! Take fingerprints and learn a secret code as you examine the evidence!  
*While recommended for 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> grades, workshop also fulfills Bear Achievement 7a.*

***It's a Draw!* \$12 PER SCOUT**

Sharpen your pencils and learn drawing techniques such as shading and perspective. Create a portfolio for your projects!  
*While recommended for 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> grades, workshop also fulfills Bear Elective 9a; Cub Scout Art Belt Loop requirements #1 & 2.*

***Geology, USA!* \$15 PER SCOUT**

Take an “aerial tour” of the United States and practice “hands-on” geology when you come in for a landing! Learn about the structure of the earth and the natural forces that continue to shape it. Sort rocks and minerals, mold fossils and more!  
*Workshop fulfills the Webelos **Geologist** Activity Badge; Cub Scout **Geology** Belt Loop and Pin.*
