



Leadership

We are pleased to report that our school leadership team has been hired. Our Founding Head of School and Assistant Head of School will be announced to the Trinity Hall community in January. These fine educators and leaders, both of whom will be joining us from prestigious independent girls' schools, are thrilled to accept this opportunity and challenge. They look forward to meeting all interested students and families this winter.

Location

Trinity Hall has secured a terrific temporary campus to house the school in its founding years. Croydon Hall, located in Northern Monmouth County, is well suited to meet Trinity Hall's curricular, co-curricular and athletic needs. Specifically, Trinity Hall will be located at 900 Leonardville Road in Middletown Township. The accoutrements of the campus include an academic building with a sufficient number of classrooms and offices; a full-sized gymnasium with a stage, fitness room and locker rooms; an all-purpose room for lunch and other activities; adequate parking; and various outdoor spaces including quality athletic fields. In addition, Trinity Hall is engaged with the owners of several local properties which we believe are fantastic sites for a permanent campus. The search for a permanent, centrally-located home for Trinity Hall will remain a priority.

Admission & Enrollment

Trinity Hall and interested year one families must work together on a three-phase application process to begin immediately. All application fees have been waived for the 2013-14 "Leadership Class."

1. Phone Call & Interview: Within the next two weeks, a Trinity Hall admission representative will be reaching out to all interested families individually. On this call, you will receive additional information about Trinity Hall and the application and enrollment processes; have an opportunity to ask questions and share concerns; and begin to schedule a winter student/parents interview date with a member of Trinity Hall's school leadership team.

2. Application Submission: A paper application – to be completed by parents and students – will be sent to all 8th graders in our database, and to any other interested families who contact us (info@trinityhallnj.org) in the coming weeks. Please complete the application first and submit at your earliest convenience, preferably on or before Saturday, January 26th – the date of the entrance exam. The accompanying forms, the student transcript release request and teacher recommendations, should be completed in a timely manner as well.

3. Entrance Exam: We welcome all interested students to join us on **Saturday, January 26th** at Christian Brothers Academy for the High School Placement Test (HSPT), offered by the Scholastic Testing Service. The Closed HSPT® provides national normative measures in the following cognitive and basic skills areas: verbal and quantitative skills, reading, mathematics, and language. **To register your daughter, please email info@trinityhallnj.org using "Entrance Exam" as the subject line.**

During and following the exam, brunch will be provided for all families. This will be a great opportunity to meet and speak with like-minded families, meet and hear from the School's founders, and most excitingly, be introduced to Trinity Hall's Founding Head of School and Assistant Head of School. Tuition & Financial Aid

The board intends to set tuition numbers for the founding years of the school at a level that will allow Trinity Hall to achieve its mission and objectives. Affordability and its impact on matriculation will be kept in the highest regard. Therefore, even in its early years, Trinity Hall will make every effort to assist families with the increasing cost of education. Financial aid will be awarded on a yearly basis to qualified students demonstrating need based on the information parents provide to our selected online financial aid assessment system. Trinity Hall will award grants, which do not have to be repaid, to bridge the gap between what a family can afford and the cost of tuition. Tuition and fees for the 2013-14 school year will be set and communicated in early January.
