Dog Got Skunked?

Here is how you get the Smell out of your dog's coat.

In a large plastic bucket or container, combine 1 quart hydrogen peroxide, 1/4 cup baking soda and 1 to 2 teaspoons of liquid hand or dish soap. Add warm water. Mix ingredients well.

The solution will fizz, as a chemical reaction is occurring. Use immediately - do not store.

Do not soak your dog with water prior to bathing. Promptly begin cleansing the affected areas thoroughly, massaging the solution deep into your dog's coat. You may wish to use a sponge or washcloth. Avoid getting the solution in the eyes, ears or mouth.

Allow the solution to remain on your dog for at least five minutes (longer if strong odor persists).

Rinse your dog well with water. Repeat the steps as necessary until odor is gone. The smell may linger slightly for a few days.
