

## **WORKSHOP: AN111 Breast Cancer Prevention**

### DESCRIPTION:

This course explores the factors that influence the risk of developing breast cancer. It involves an in-depth exploration of (1) the anatomy and physiology of the breasts; (2) the causes, types and stages of breast cancer; (3) diagnostic tools and predictive tests used to detect breast conditions; (4) the relationship between the environment, hormones, nutrition, psychospiritual health, immunity and breast cancer; and (5) treatment methods for dealing with breast cancer - both conventional and alternative.
