How massage therapy and acupuncture can help



Oncology massage can help with reducing anxiety and relieving pain. Some studies also show significant decrease in respiratory rates, as well as a significant increase in white blood cells and natural killer cell activity, suggesting a benefit to the immune system.



Oncology acupuncture can relieve nausea and vomiting caused by chemotherapy and may help improve immune system function. According to the National Institutes for Health, studies have shown that acupuncture may alter brain chemistry in ways that affect the body's immune reactions, blood pressure regulation, blood flow and temperature, and it may aid in the activity of endorphins and immune cells at specific sites in the body.
