Rules and Regulations

1. By submitting a registration form, a registrant agrees to abide by the rules and regulations listed and will accept the decision of the Event Superintendent as final. Everyone older than 16 years of age should have a valid state fishing license. Before fishing, every angler must register and pay the designated registration table. The registration table will be located at the Camp Charis boat ramp. Anglers are expected to exercise courtesy at all times toward fellow anglers. Evidence of poor sportsmanship will be cause for disqualification. All minors must be under the supervision of an adult.

 Camp Charis, Pelham Chamber of Commerce, and Pelham Middle FFA, or it's governing bodies, are not liable for any injuries or property damages. Fish at your own risk.

3. All fish entered must be caught at Camp Charis on the day of the event within the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 11 a.m. Those starting before 7:30 a.m. will automatically be disqualified. All fish entered in the rodeo must be brought to the Event Superintendent no later than 11:00 a.m. No fish will be accepted after this time. Please bring your own container to transport your fish to the Event Superintendent station. Judging will be on the basis of most caught, and largest (total body length) fish caught. These will be decided by fish weight. There are no limitations on rod weight or strength of line in any category.

Categories:

- Bass Angler: 13 years and older. Angler must use a level wind casting reel, conventional spinning or spincasting reel, or fly rod.
   Only artificial bait will be allowed, no live bait. Prizes will be awarded for the largest (total body length) bass caught.
- Sportsman Angler: 13 years and older. Any type of rod/reel, cane pole, crappie pole is allowed. Either live bait or artificial is allowed. Prizes will be awarded for the most bream/crappie/catfish combination caught.
- Junior Bass Angler: 12 years and younger. Angler must use a level wind casting reel, conventional spinning or spincasting reel, or fly rod. Only artificial bait will be allowed, no live bait. <u>Prizes will be awarded for the largest (total body length) bass caught.</u>
- Junior Sportsman Angler: 12 years and younger. Any type of rod/reel, cane pole, crappie pole is allowed. Either live bait or artificial is allowed. Prizes will be awarded for the most bream/crappie/catfish combination caught.
