These grants are intended to support operating/program purposes such as salary and benefits, insurance, rent, educational materials, etc... These grants are limited to new worshiping communities that are related to the Presbyterian Church (USA), located within the United States and Puerto Rico and were established no earlier than July, 2010.

New worshiping communities may apply for a one-time <u>Seed Grant</u> of up to \$7,500. Six months after receipt of a Seed Grant, a one-time <u>Investment Grant</u> of up to \$17,500 is possible.

Seed Grants do not require matching funds. However, Investment Grants ordinarily require a 50% dollar-for-dollar match (\$8,750) to be provided by the combined contributions of the participating partner congregation(s) and mid councils.

We also offer grants for New Church Development and Presbytery-Level Congregational Transformation.
