Did You Know...

Safety	Safety is a top priority for the PBC. The PBC helps fund a concussion management program and beginning in 2014 will help provide funding for athletic trainer services.			
Sports Waivers	The PBC helps high school and middle school athletes who cannot afford the pay-to-participate fees. The PBC pays half the fee and in return these athletes volunteer hours to help run athletic events.

Scholarships	The PBC offers several college scholarships. For many years the PBC has provided the Buck Philpott and Gary Cox scholarships through generous donations from those families. In addition, the PBC Warrior scholarship program began in 2012 for athletes whose families are active volunteers. Five \$750 Warrior scholarships have been awarded over the last 2 years.			
Sports Physicals	The PBC coordinates with local physicians to offer sports physicals at significantly reduced rates. These physicians donate their time and all or part of the greatly reduced fee back to the PBC. (<i>Thanks to Philomath Family Medicine!</i>)			
Play-offs	When teams make play-offs and have to travel overnight, the PBC helps fund some of these additional costs. Over \$2,000 in each of the last two years
