Overview of the activity of our organization:

MEPN is a U.S.- based, independent, nonpartisan, 501(c)(3) nonprofit catalyst for action in the battle for peace in the Middle East. It uses private diplomacy to complement the activities of the Middle Eastern governments in their pursuit of conflict resolution and lasting peace, primarily between Arabs and Israelis, by facilitating dialogue within and across conflict divides.
