"Maybe someone else will give you a try."


So now here we are, all confused and alone...

1. Cat toys.
 2. Flea medications like Advantage, Frontline, Revolution for cats.
 3. Paper towels.
 3. Roccal disinfectant.
 4. Terramycin (eye ointment)
 5. Animax
 6. Feline Pine or Equine Pinet litter.
 7. Dry Food for cats (we feed Kirkland from Costco Dry and Friskie's wet (NO FISH FLAVORS PLEASE),
We also Feed Science Diet dry.
 8. Fleece blankets, cat beds, cat scratchers
 9. L-Lysine (if possible Twin Lab caps)
 10. Laundry detergent, dish soap, bleach.
 11. catnip.
 12. Break away cat collars (no black colors please, as these collars are used to identify our black kitties).
 13. Paper plates.
 14. Cat beds.
 15. Fleece Blankets.
 16. Memory foam mattress toppers of any size (we cut them up and make cat beds for our senior kitties and for those with mobility issues with these).
